Bugs Byte!

Protect Your Computer's Hard Drive

- 1. Update your virus protection on a regular basis.
- 2. Check for and run Windows Critical Updates.
- 3. Back up your data.
- 4. Create a system restore date before adding hardware or software.
- 5. Do not open e-mails from people you do not know.
- 6. Use Windows Clean Sweep to remove Temporary Internet Files and Cookies.
- 7. Beware of downloading programs, music, and games. They contain Spyware. Spyware can slow your system and cause pop-ups. Certain sites, such as casino gambling game sites, are particularly risky as many contain Trojan horses and other malware that enter your computer as soon as you visit these sites, unbeknownst to you.
