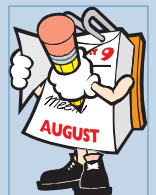

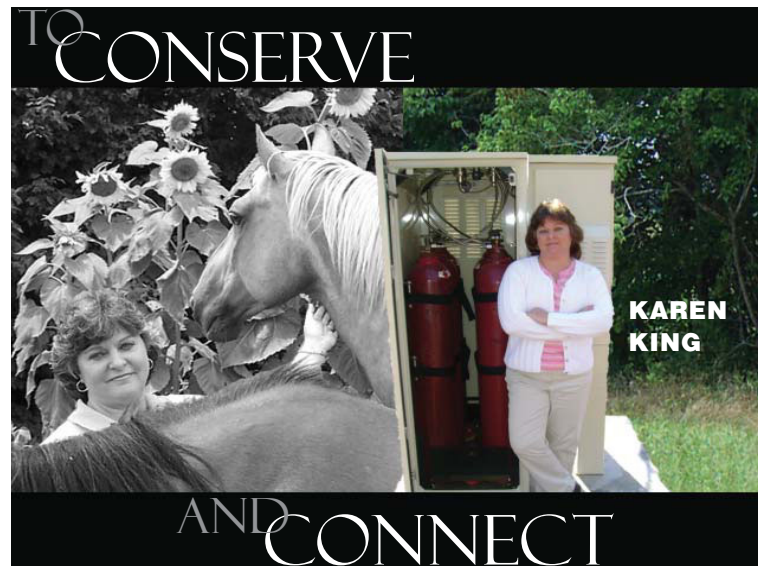
## *Use Of Hydro Generators Helps Protect Our Rural Environment*

Karen King has been an employee at Randolph Telephone for seven years. When she's not on the job, she enjoys spending time on the family farm growing their garden and tending to their horses, chickens, guineas, cats, and dogs.

Born and raised snapping beans and shucking corn, Karen has a deep appreciation for a green thumb and a green environment. Like Karen, we at Randolph Telephone are always looking for ways to protect the farms and rural communities we serve. Our recent purchase of Relion Hydro generators will enable us to do just that, while continuing to provide reliable service even more efficiently than we have in the past.

Most people don't realize that the phone lines are dependant on power, and that the phones go out when the power goes down. For years, we have relied on traditional generators and batteries as a backup power source to maintain your phone lines during bad weather or power failure. While this method of power generation is still viable, it has become costly with the price of fuel on the rise and creates the potential for environmental contamination in the event of a leak.

Hydro generators use cutting edge technology to combine hydrogen gas with oxygen to produce a cleaner form of energy, resulting in a by-product of only water and heat. They also reduce the noise pollution of a gas-powered generator to a



low hum. Since this process allows up to 96 hours of maintenance free power versus the 48 to 72 hours afforded with previous generator types, fuel cell technology is more cost effective and frees up our human resources for customer service.

As we strive to be progressive with new technologies and methods of communication, we always maintain our mission to stay true to our roots. We are neighbors helping neighbors because we live here too. ■
